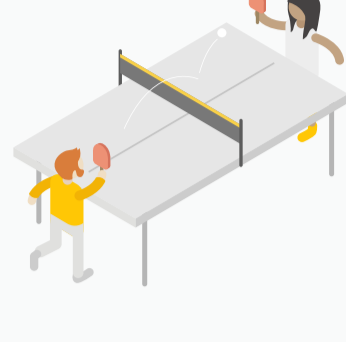

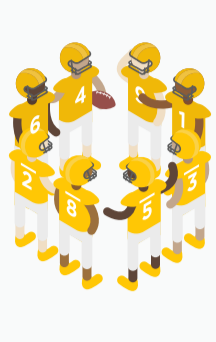
More flexible collaboration

Share your work with one—or many

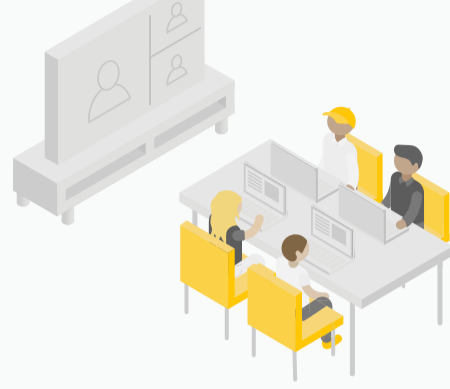
Whether users need to chat one on one, huddle around a shared Word doc, or meet up in the virtual conference room, Teams is the place to be.

Users can @mention a specific person, create a channel name for anyone who favorites the channel, or assign a team name for all members.

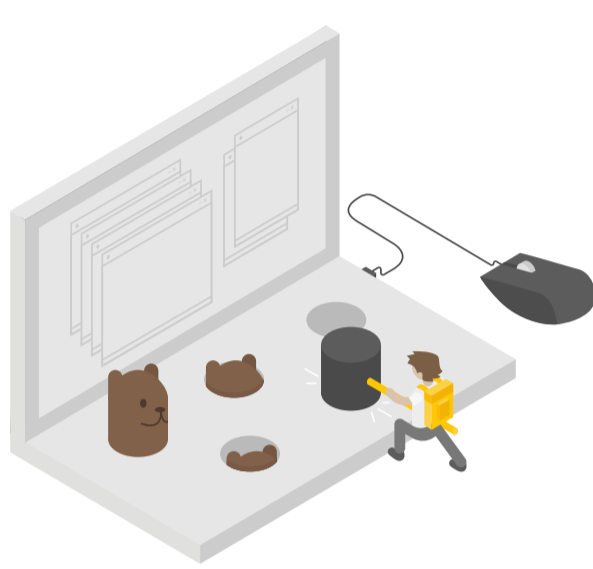
Skype? That's old-school collaboration. With Teams, your workflow is searchable, shareable, and safe.

Did you know the average employee has 10 desktop apps open at once? All that bouncing from app to app wastes productivity and feels like whack-a-mole.

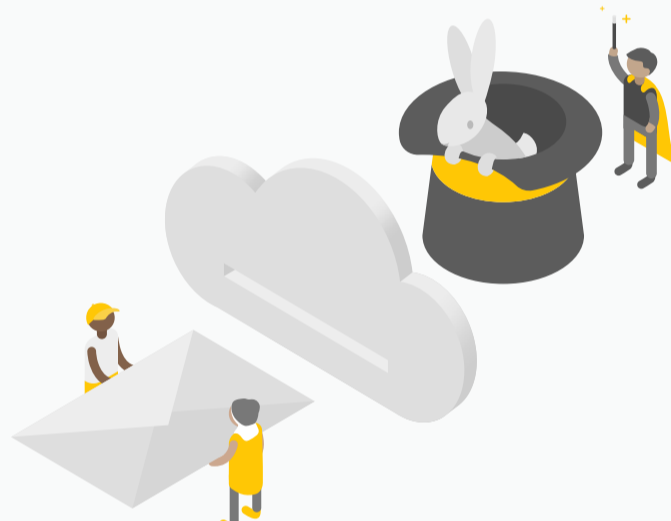

Attach a file to your conversation and access it anytime in the cloud



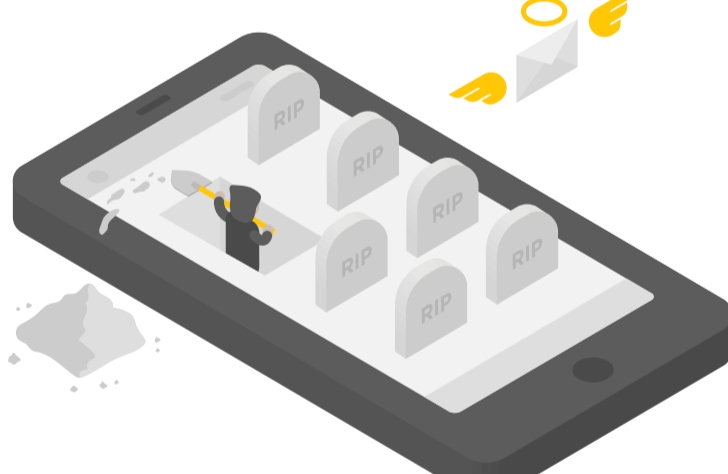
With Teams, there's no need to fret about where a file is, who can see it, and how to manage permissions. All the technical magic happens behind the scenes.

These days, email is where your attachments go to die. Need to find a document in Teams but can't remember the file name? No problem; just look within archived team conversations.

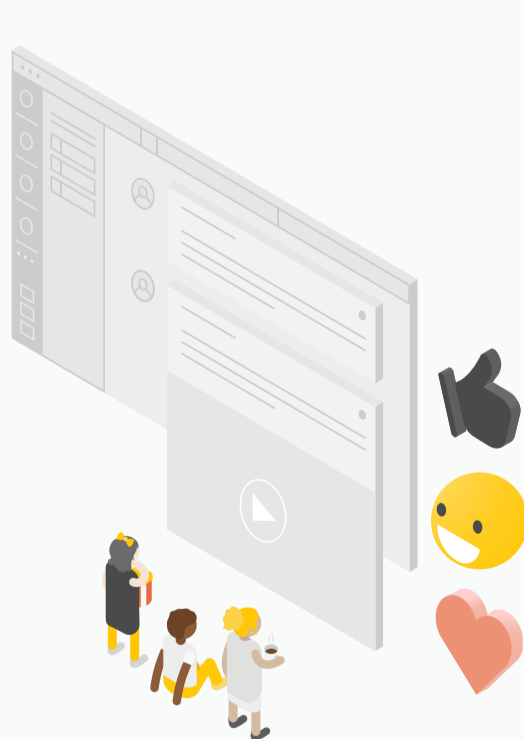
